Community Outreach - Community Events:

Walk with a Doc - In partnership with the Beaver County YMCA, we are one of over 400 chapters worldwide! Residents give a brief presentation on a health topic and then lead participants on a walk at their own pace while answering a variety of medical questions from the participants.

Beaver County Drug Abuse Coalition - While on their Community Medicine rotation, residents participate in the monthly meetings of the Drug Abuse Coalition. Through the efforts of this coalition, Beaver County has seen a 50% reduction in deaths from drug overdose in the last 2 years.

Beaver Falls Community Crime Watch Day - An offshoot of the "National Night Out" that falls under the Neighborhood Watch umbrella. Its purpose is to bring the community and police together and is hosted at our local Geneva College.

"Ask a Doc" - Utilizing our "Ask a Doc" booth residents participate in a number of local events including the Beaver Falls Spring Festival, Heritage Valley Health Fairs, "What's on Your Plate" Food and Wellness Expo and many more. We answer a variety of medical questions and distribute educational information on the services we provide.

Men's Health Group - Residents provide medical education to local church's men's associations.

"Friday Fun Day" - Our annual Community Health Fair in Beaver Falls that is hosted by our program which has over 30 community organizations participating. We provide free health screenings, school/sports physicals and medical exams for the uninsured. Free food, kids' games and activities, music, and raffle prizes make this event a success year after year.
