Officially named the Encompass Health Rehabilitation Hospital of Sewickley at Heritage Valley Kennedy, the unit will function as a satellite expansion unit of the main facility located in Sewickley. The location will provide rehabilitation care for patients recovering from strokes and other neurological disorders, brain injuries, hip fractures, and complex orthopedic conditions.

Patients of the unit benefit from exceptional care that is standard to both organizations. Those receiving care will experience a minimum of three hours per day of therapy for five days each week from a multidisciplinary therapy team, 24-hour nursing care, access to advanced technologies, and frequent visits by an attending physician during their stay.

Heritage Valley's Commitment to Behavioral Health Care

Heritage Valley Health System has a history of providing behavioral health care for the patients in the communities it serves. The Health System provides comprehensive behavioral health care services in both inpatient and outpatient settings.

Most recently, Heritage Valley established a new, state-of-the-art Adult Behavioral Health Care Unit at Heritage Valley Kennedy hospital. The new 24-bed unit complements a similar, well-established inpatient Adult Behavioral Health Care unit located at Heritage Valley Beaver. Both inpatient care units focus on the treatment and care of individuals, ages 18 and older, with behavioral health disorders including, but not limited to, major depression, bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, and other psychotic disorders and co-occurring diseases.

Additionally, on the Heritage Valley Kennedy campus, a separate Geriatric Behavioral Health Unit provides short-term inpatient services for those over the age of 55 who have mental health needs. Many of these patients also have concurrent medical conditions. The unit is one of the few Geropsychiatric facilities in Western Pennsylvania. Behavioral health staff collaborate with Heritage Valley Kennedy's medical staff to ensure that medical and psychiatric needs are addressed simultaneously.

Beyond the inpatient care at Heritage Valley Kennedy and Heritage Valley Beaver hospitals, Heritage Valley has a long-standing partnership with Staunton Clinic to provide outpatient behavioral health care services. The outpatient department at Staunton Clinic offers a full range of diagnostic and treatment services across the lifespan.
