Northwest EMS ... Safely and Quickly Transporting Our Patients

A subsidiary of Heritage Valley Health System, NorthWest EMS is one of Allegheny County's largest Emergency Medical Service providers, offering emergency medical care and ambulance transport. Northwest EMS services 16 neighboring communities: Avalon, Bellevue, Ben Avon, Ben Avon Heights, Crafton, Emsworth, Findlay Township, Ingram, Kennedy Township, Kilbuck Township, McDonald, McKees Rocks, North Fayette Township, Oakdale, Pittsburgh International Airport and Stowe Township.

NorthWest EMS is composed of more than 100 Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs), Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians (AEMTs), Paramedics, Prehospital RNs (PHRNs) and support staff. We have 13 licensed Advanced Life Support ambulances, four Advanced Life Support response vehicles and a utility support vehicle. Northwest EMS also provides the drivers for Heritage Valley Kennedy's courtesy van service.

Heritage Valley's Mobile Imaging ... we go the extra mile so you don't have to! Heritage Valley offers mobile Mammography, MRI, CT and PET-CT services at six convenient locations: our Medical Neighborhoods located in Calcutta, Chippewa, Ellwood City and Center Township, and our Women's Health Centers in Center and Robinson Townships. These mobile services are part of Heritage Valley's integrated delivery network of healthcare, so you can be assured that your services will all be connected through Heritage Valley's electronic health record system. To schedule a diagnostic imaging procedure, please call 866-901-4624 (IMAG). Screening mammograms may be scheduled through the Heritage Valley app using My Care Link.

MRI. We know that patients are often anxious when it comes to having an MRI performed, and want the test to be completed as quickly as possible. Heritage Valley has recently updated the software in its mobile wide-bore MRI units, which means faster exam times with even better image quality! In fact, this new software could reduce test times by as much as 20 minutes. Because the exam is finished more quickly, there is less chance of a patient moving ... and less chance of the test needing to be repeated. Less time in the MRI machine = less anxiety for our patients! Heritage Valley is one of the first healthcare systems in the area to have this new GE software.

CT Scans. Our 64-slice General Electric Optima scanner is equipped with all of the technological "bells and whistles." Designed to make the imaging process safer and faster for patients, the scanner's improved image quality aids our Radiologists and Physicians with their diagnoses. Best of all, our dose reduction software decreases radiation exposure by an average of 38%.

PET-CT Scans. A Positron Emission Tomography (PET) scan is a nuclear medicine imaging test. PET uses radioactive matter to show how organs and tissues are working, which helps to pinpoint disease. These scans provide detailed 3D images of bone, tissue and organs. A PET-CT scan is an effective way to help identify a variety of conditions, including cancer, heart disease and brain disorders.

Mammography. Mammograms are performed to screen healthy women for signs of breast cancer and to evaluate women who may have symptoms. Combining a yearly mammogram, monthly breast self-examinations and a yearly clinical breast exam provides women ages 40 and over with the best means of early detection of breast abnormalities. Women who experience an abnormal finding during a screening mammogram are referred for a diagnostic evaluation. If you are referred for additional testing, Heritage Valley's BreastCare Navigator or Patient Advocate will make the necessary appointments for you. All of Heritage Valley's mammography locations offer Self-Requesting Screening Mammograms, which means that a patient may self-schedule a screening mammogram without an order from a physician.

The Heritage Valley Kennedy Pulmonary Rehabilitation Center has been helping patients breathe easier for 20 years! We provide the highest level of care to our patients, treating a range of respiratory conditions including Asthma, Bronchitis, Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), Emphysema, Pulmonary Fibrosis, Pulmonary Hypertension and Pre/Post Lung Transplantation. We have also provided relief for many post-COVID patients.

We offer one-on-one sessions with a Respiratory Therapist and Occupational Therapist. Upon completion of the program, patients have the option to participate in our "Maintenance Program," in which they continue their exercise independently in a supervised setting. 
